Over the past 4+ years, I've worked on many businesses, teams, and projects including full site redesigns, foundational code standardizations, and site migrations to AWS. I've had the opportunity to lead larger projects on the front and back end, from planning to deployment to leading support with our end users. Purposefully joining a team with front and back end needs in 2021, I was able to grow my Node and AWS skillset while still specializing on the front end.
